**NOTIFICATION**

The State Government had earlier notified 354 (Three Hundred Fifty Four) Centralized Procurement Centres (CPCs) in 1<sup>st</sup> phase vide Memo No. 3648-FS/Sectt/Food/4P-06/2020 dated 27.10.2021 and 108 (One Hundred and Eight) CPCs in 2<sup>nd</sup> phase vide no. 3918-FS/Sectt/Food/4P-12/2021 dated 13.11.2021 for purchase of paddy from the farmers during KMS 2021-22.

The State Government has now decided to set up 5 (Five) more additional CPCs in the District of Bankura to be run under the administrative control of the Director of DDP&S, Food & Supplies Department as per the table below. The CPCs will run from 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2021.

Further each CPC must have the requisite infrastructure like moisture meters, electronic weighing machine, computer desktop /TAB etc., to facilitate procurement of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) paddy. In case the paddy is not lifted by the rice mills in time, adequate facility for temporary storage within the premises of the CPC must be identified to prevent any damage of the procured paddy. Each CPC must have a proper hoarding displaying all relevant information for the farmers including FAQ rice, MSP, documents required for registration etc. Details of the three men committee for resolving disputes (if any) should be displayed at the CPC.
